- Aggressive behavior and pets off leash will not be tolerated. They must be on a 4-6' fixed-length leash and under your control when outside your RV, except when inside the Bark Park.
- As always, pick up your own pet's poop immediately and do not allow them to urinate on guests' signs and yard decorations.
- Pets are not allowed in any buildings to include the Welcome Center, Mailroom, Activity Center nor the pool area.
- We appreciate all the guests who are following the rules which help make this a pet-friendly resort!

Departure Process for those leaving us

- If you are leaving earlier than your reservation departure date, please advise the office so we can add it to our daily list
- Tow dolly retrieval requires 2 days' notice to have it delivered to your site
- Mailbox keys can be returned to mail center (use drop box if closed)
- Provide self-addressed labels for any first class mail you want forwarded
- Modems can be scheduled to be picked up or you can leave it on your picnic table but please ensure we know what day you are leaving so we can retrieve it
 - \$50 modem deposit refund will be applied to final electric bill
- Final meter read
 - We will read after you release your site and apply to your invoice, or
 - You can take a picture of your meter the morning before you leave and bring it to the office
- Welcome signs
 - You may store your welcome sign in your RV to ensure you have it when you return, or
 - You may turn it in to the mailroom since the Activity Office is closed for the summer. All signs will be returned to the Activity Office when they open in the Fall.

On-site Summer Storage

- Storage fees must be paid prior to departure.
- Water hoses, sewer hoses, cables must be removed.
- Place power cord in black corrugated pipe or PVC pipe to prevent mower and weed-eater damage.
- No items can be left on site except for stairs. Other items can become projectiles during high winds.
- If you want us to automatically charge your monthly electric bill through the summer, please ensure we have a Credit Card Authorization form on file
- If you are keeping your modem inside your RV during the summer please call the office to have it turned off to avoid internet charges through the summer. When you return in the Fall you can have it turned back on.

Maintenance and Grounds

- Maintenance has completed 651 work orders so far this season! Thank you for letting us know when something is broken or not working correctly.
- Please remember that the dumpsters are for household trash and broken-down boxes only!
- Furniture, mattresses, and household items such as TVs, appliances, fire pits etc. need to be taken to one of the three landfills in the area. The best one to use is at 14450 Landfill Rd, which is off Ponce De Leon.
- Please do not place large household items in the dumpster as they take up too much room and we've seen what an overfull dumpster looks like.
- Please do not place these items next to the dumpster either because it makes the area look trashy and can be hard for the trucks to get the dumpster in and out safely.
- If you have plants or garden items you don't want, please see if Monica wants to use them in our Serenity Garden!
- Mowing will continue throughout the summer. Please remember to pick up your yard items to make it easier for our mowing crew.
