- **Renewal Time is here!**
  - **No rate increases for 2025-2026!!**
  - **Phase 1: Guests who want to keep their same site for next season (4mo or longer) need to complete the Renewal Form and turn in by 12noon on Monday, 3/3/26.**
  - **Phase 2: We will send out a list of all available sites on Tuesday, March 4<sup>th</sup> so the guests who did not renew for their same site will be able to select their 1st, 2nd, and 3rd preferences for a different site. This renewal form will need to be turned in by 12noon on Monday 3/10/26.**
- **Departure Process for those leaving us 😞**
  - **If you are leaving earlier than your reservation departure date, please advise the office so we can add it to our daily list.**
  - **Tow dolly retrieval requires 2 days' notice to have it delivered to your site**
  - **Mailbox keys can be returned to mail center (use drop box if closed)**
  - **Provide self-addressed labels for any first class mail you want forwarded**
  - **Modems can be scheduled to be picked up or you can bring it to the office. Please remember to return the plug-in and cable as well.**
    - **\$50 deposit refund will be applied to final electric**
  - **Final meter read**
    - **We will read meter after your RV is gone from the site and apply to your invoice, or**
    - **You can take a picture of your meter the afternoon before you leave and bring it to the office**
- **On-site Summer Storage**
  - **Pay storage fees prior to departure**
  - **Water hoses, sewer hoses, cables must be removed**
  - **Place power cord in black corrugated pipe or PVC pipe to prevent mower and weed-eater damage**
  - **No items can be left on site except for stairs. Other items can become projectiles during high winds.**

## Maintenance and Grounds

- **Maintenance has completed 656 work orders so far this season!**
- **Please remember that the dumpsters are for household trash and broken-down boxes only!**
- **Furniture, mattresses, and household items such as TVs, appliances, fire pits, etc. need to be taken to one of the three landfills in the area. The best one to use is at 14450 Landfill Rd, which is off Ponce De Leon.**
- **If you have useable items you do not want to take with you, please do not leave them outside the dumpsters; clutter draws pests and is unappealing. Take a picture of usable items and post it to the Friends In Belle Parc Facebook group as **Free Items** – be sure to include your site number. Other guests may gladly pick it up at your site. Or, thrift stores would also love to have it.**
