### Safety Corner

- Snakes

### Laundry Facilities

- One facility is behind Maintenance Bldg. (dedicated machines for pet beds, blankets, etc.). Other facility is behind the Fitness Center
- Please let Reservations Office know if a machine is not working
- Purchase rolls of quarters at Reservations Office, Mail Center, or Activities Office

Quiet hours are from 10pm to 8am. Please be courteous of all your neighbors – noise carries far from your site.

### Pets

- All pets must be walked on a 4-6ft non-retractable (fixed) leash and guest must be with them and within 4-6 feet of them anytime they are outside.
- Please visit our fenced Barc Parc near the off-site storage area for your pets to enjoy off-leash time!
- Please treat other guests' yard as you would want them to treat yours and do not walk pets in their area or let them urinate on anything in their yard.
- Remember to always pick up after your pet (yup, the poo!) and place it in the Mutt Mitt station. **Please do not place in the garbage cans.**

- If you are leaving your RV here, please let us know if anyone has access to your RV in case of emergency
- Let the Mail Center know so they can hold your mail until your return

## Mail Center (352) 593-5852 Option #4

- We received 1,703 packages in the mailroom in November!
- Typically, if we know you and see you walking up to the mail center, we may grab your packages and mail and have them ready for you. However, if we are busy counting or sorting packages, we cannot do this. Please ensure you bring your mailbox key each time.
- We do ask that you pick up your packages each day so we have room for deliveries the following day!
- **Very Important:** After retrieving your package from a cubby please lock the cubby door and then drop the key into the drop box on the counter.

## Maintenance and Grounds

- With all the packages we receive in December please ensure you break down the boxes before putting in the dumpster so there is room for everyone's household trash!
- Please do not use the large roll-off dumpster in the storage area as we get fined if the incorrect items are placed in there. This is for maintenance use only.
- Furniture, mattresses, and household items such as TVs, appliances, fire pits, etc. need to be taken to one of the three landfills in the area. The best one to use is at 14450 Landfill Rd, which is off Ponce De Leon.
- Did you know we loan out mowers, weed-eaters, and a pressure washer? Just call the office and they will ensure you have already signed a waiver form, submit a work order to have it delivered to your site, typically the next day, Monday - Friday.
- We also have lawn/leaf rakes at the Reservations Office that you can pick up and we'll give you a bag for the leaves. Leave the bag by the side of the road and maintenance will pick it up!
- Mowing will be completed when needed, based on rainfall so be prepared to move any objects that will be in the way of mowing.
