Dedicated Smoking Area

We are testing a dedicated smoking area behind the Activity Center at the edge of the pavers/covered porch.

Smokers should stay 25' from the back screen door so that we are in compliance with the Florida Clean Air Act and State Constitution or it will be removed.

- A Lost and Found box is located on the counter in the Mail Center lobby.

- If you have a letter key in your mailbox it will match one of the larger cubbies above or below the mailboxes. Please lock the box after retrieving your package and drop the letter key in the drop box on the counter.

Payments

Pets

- All pets must be walked on a 4-6ft non-retractable (fixed) leash and guest must be with them and within 4-6 feet of them anytime they are outside.
- Please visit our fenced Barc Parc near the off-site storage area for your pets to enjoy off-leash time!
- Please treat other guests' yard as you would want them to treat yours and do not walk pets in their area or let them urinate on anything in their yard.

Quiet hours are from 10pm to 8am. Please be courteous of all your neighbors – noise carries far from your site.

Maintenance and Grounds

- **Mowing is currently being done as needed due to minimal rain**
- Please remember that the dumpsters are for household trash and broken-down boxes only! Please do not use the large roll-off dumpster in the storage area.
- Furniture, mattresses, and household items such as TVs, appliances, fire pits, etc. need to be taken to one of the three landfills in the area. The best one to use is at 14450 Landfill Rd, which is off Ponce De Leon.
- Please do not attach anything to picnic tables or decks on the lakefront; holes destroy the wood.
- If you want to make any changes to your site, including plantings, please request the Site Improvement form from the office (must have at least a 6mo reservation).
- If you would like to store an extra vehicle please see the office for a permit.
- **FIRE ANTS? Stop by the maintenance building for granules that destroy the mound. If no one is there please stop by the Reservations Office. Keeping the mound moist will settle them down. Please note the difference between the Fire Ants (dome-shaped mounds) and the beneficial Pyramid ants (circular crater or mound around an entrance hole. Pictures are on bulletin boards.**
