**Pets**

- All pets must be walked on a 4-6ft non-retractable (fixed) leash and guest must be with them and within 4-6 feet of them anytime they are outside.
- Please visit our fenced Barc Parc near the off-site storage area for your pets to enjoy off-leash time!
- Please treat other guests' yard as you would want them to treat yours and do not walk pets in their area or let them urinate on anything in their yard.
- To avoid getting lint, pet hair, etc. on your clothing and blankets, a guest recommended a lint ball (at Walmart for \$5-\$6) to use in the washer and dryer!

### Mail Center (352) 593-5852 Option #4

- We received a total of 1,875 packages in December!
- Please pick up mail/packages daily as we receive over 100 packages per day!
- A Lost and Found box is located on the counter in the Mail Center lobby.
- Brochures for local "Things to Do" can also be found in the lobby.
- If you have a letter key in your mailbox it will match one of the larger cubbies above or below the mailboxes. Please lock the box after retrieving your package and drop the letter key in the drop box on the counter.

- Call or email for work order requests. If reporting a broken washer and/or dryer please let us know what location and the number on the machine

- You can wash road dirt when you first arrive for free. Additional RV washes are \$10 and vehicle washes are \$5. Park models are \$25. Please pay at the office!

#### Payments

- You can call, email, or come by the office to make payments for site fees, electric, and high-speed internet.
  - You can also set up auto payments by signing an authorization form at the office
- Please enjoy your stay and let us know if there is anything we can do for you!

### Maintenance and Grounds (Emergencies after hours 352-587-7172)

- Mowing is currently being done as needed due to minimal rain
- Please remember that the dumpsters are for household trash and broken-down boxes only! Please do not use the large roll-off dumpster in the storage area.
- Furniture, mattresses, and household items such as TVs, appliances, fire pits, etc. need to be taken to one of the three landfills in the area. The best one to use is at 14450 Landfill Rd, which is off Ponce De Leon.
- Please do not attach anything to picnic tables or decks on the lakefront; water seeping into holes destroys the wood. Also, please do not attach any chains or locks on your electric pedestal.
- If you want to make any changes to your site, including plantings, please request the Site Improvement form from the office (must have at least a 6mo reservation). Written approval must be obtained in advance – Site Improvement forms available at the office
- Please take down all Christmas decorations and electrical cords by January 10th.
- Firepits at sites must be off the ground and never left unattended. Also, no campfires on the decks of lakefront sites.
