 - Do not walk pets off leash, even in the dark as other pets and wildlife may startle them.

- All pets must be on a 4-6ft non-retractable (fixed-length) leash and under guests' control when outdoors. They should not be left outside without a guest with them.
- Please visit our fenced Barc Parc near the off-site storage area for your pets to enjoy off-leash time!
- As always, pick up your own pet's poop immediately and do not allow them to urinate on guests' signs and yard decorations! Pets should not be more than 1' onto another guest's site unless invited.

- **Renewal Time coming!**
 - When we receive the 2026-2027 rates, we will begin renewals for all guests who are here for at least 4 months and want to return next season for at least 4 months.
 - Phase 1: This phase will be for the guests who want to keep their same site. You will complete a renewal form and we will remove your site from the available list.
 - Phase 2: We will send out a list of all available sites and the guests who did not renew for their same site will be able to select their 1st, 2nd, and 3rd preferences for a different site. If more than 1 guest requests the same site, the guest with the longest reservation request will be awarded that site. If both guests have the same length stay then the guest who has been coming here the most months will prevail. More info to come!
- **Work Orders**
 - If you see something that needs attention, please call or email the office so we can fill out a work order.
 - If you find a washer or dryer that is out of order, please let the reservations office know which machine number and which facility so a work order can be submitted.
- **Rolls of Quarters**
 - You can purchase rolls of quarters for the laundry at the Reservation Office and Mail Center (Mon-Fri 9am-5pm, Sat 10am-4pm), and Activity Center (Mon-Sat 10am-2pm)
- **RV and Vehicle Wash**
 - Additional RV washes while staying in the resort are \$25 and additional car washes are \$5. Park Models are \$25. Please pay at the office!

- If you are expecting packages/mail for someone other than the name(s) on your reservation, including nicknames, please let the Mail Center know. This will prevent it from being returned to sender. Correct site number is helpful as well!
- Please make sure you lock the cubby after retrieving your package and drop off the key in the drop box on top of the counter.
