### Safety Corner

We are working with County Emergency Services to ensure emergency vehicles can get into the gate and to the correct site when they are called.

- **911 Address: EMS needs the 5-digit code that is on your lamp post AND your street name. Reservations office can give you a new label if you need it.**
- We do not change the gate code very often due to the issues in keeping the emergency agencies updated. Please do not share the gate code with anyone other than emergency services.
- We recommend staying on the phone with 911 Dispatch until the emergency vehicle arrives to give information as needed.
- Hernando County Sheriff's Office has an app that will show your location. Download is available at [apps.myocv.com/share/a32434601](https://apps.myocv.com/share/a32434601) or through Google Play or App Store. A pin at the bottom of the app labeled *Where Am I?* will give your current location as long as you allow the app to follow you (only when you are using the app).
- This app also is an easy way to contact the Sheriff's Office for non-emergencies, such as suspicious activity within the Resort. We recommend calling the Sheriff's Office any time you see any suspicious activity within the Resort or if you feel unsafe. They have assured us that they welcome these calls and you are not being a bother.

## Mail Center (352) 593-5852 Option #4

- We had a total of 2184 packages delivered in February!
- Due to multiple interruptions, we will be closing the window to Mail Center office upon receipt of numerous packages and will re-open the window when all packages have been sorted and placed on the shelves or in cubby boxes. Thank you for your patience!
- If you are departing for the season please bring your mailbox key to the mail center. If we are closed you can drop it in the drop box on the counter.
- Please stop the mail forward to here a week prior to you leaving.
- Please confirm we have your forwarding address and provide self-addressed labels for any first class mail you want forwarded.

- **Renewal Time is almost here!**
  - We are waiting for the final word about possible rate changes, at which time we will inform everyone about Phase 1 (renew for same site) and Phase 2 (renew for different site).
  - If you are leaving prior to renewals starting but want to renew your site for at least 4 months next season, please inform the Reservations staff.
- **Departure Process for those leaving us** 😞
  - If you are leaving earlier than your reservation departure date, please advise the office so we can add it to our daily list.
  - Tow dolly retrieval requires 2 days' notice to have it delivered to your site
  - Mailbox keys can be returned to mail center (use drop box if closed)
  - Provide self-addressed labels for any first class mail you want forwarded
  - Modems can be scheduled to be picked up or you can bring it to the office. Please remember to return the plug-in and cable as well.
    - \$50 deposit refund will be applied to final electric
  - Final meter read
    - We will read meter after your RV is gone from the site and apply to your invoice, or
    - You take a picture of your meter the afternoon before you leave and bring it to the office to settle your invoice.
- **On-site Summer Storage**
  - We now have a form for all guests storing for the summer that will be sent by email, or you can pick one up at the office to complete prior to leaving.
  - Pay storage fees prior to departure
  - Place power cord in black corrugated pipe or PVC pipe to prevent mower and weed-eater damage
  - Let the mailroom know what to do with your mail while you are gone

## Maintenance and Grounds

- **Maintenance has completed 540 work orders so far this season!**
- Please remember that the dumpsters are for household trash and broken-down boxes only! Call the office for bulk drop-off location.
- **Furniture, mattresses, and household items such as TVs, appliances, fire pits, etc. need to be taken to one of the three landfills in the area. The best one to use is at 14450 Landfill Rd, which is off Ponce De Leon.**
- If you have items you do not want to take with you, please do not leave them outside the dumpsters as it looks trashy. You can post a picture of it in front of your RV and post it on our Facebook page as **Free Items!** Many other guests will gladly pick it up at your site.
